I hope you are well! As we begin our third week with remote learning, I'd like to share an update with you regarding **student attendance**. The NYC DOE is **requiring** all schools to report daily student attendance beginning Monday April 6, 2020.

To ensure we have accurate attendance we have created a new attendance protocol. Students and parents can access the **new Google Attendance Form on our school's website PS205.org**. Students will have to choose their class and name from a pre-populated drop-down menu. Record each day's attendance only ONCE. Younger students will require some assistance.

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Students must fill out the attendance form found on the **PS205.org** website on a daily basis, Monday through Friday.
- If you are absent, please notify your teacher.
