New student classes will be included in your child's report card. Pre-K and Kindergarten parents will be receiving an email about class placement in the next few weeks.

Currently, all NYC schools are deep in conversation and planning about possible school fall reopening. We do not know for sure what type of teaching/learning model we will have, but under the current DOE guidance we are planning for a possible blended learning model. Blended learning means that students learn at home and in school a few days a week.
