For those students who will be in blended learning, cohort A or B, you should have received an <u>email notification from our parent coordinator</u>, Ms. Lilly Chu, today. Our school will adhere to the following approved schedule:

School Schedule for Students 8:30 – 2:00

Teacher Office Hours 2:00 - 2:20 (phone call or email only)

Teacher Preparation Period 2:20 – 2:50

Students may only come to school on their designated day. If a student comes to school on an unscheduled day, the child must be picked up and continue their learning remotely at home. All students should arrive to school wearing their face masks. If a child does not have a face mask, one will be provided for them. Temperatures will be taken each morning. Specific arrival and dismissal information will be forthcoming.

We are still awaiting direction from the NYC DOE regarding students in remote learning.

In most years, classroom teachers ask families for specific classroom supplies. This year, all families will be receiving the same supply list. These supplies may be used for in-person or remote instruction, and you may place the supplies that fit in a gallon-sized clear Ziploc® bag. Please write your child's name on the bag in permanent marker. The supplies will be only for your child and will be kept in your child's backpack. If you need assistance in purchasing the school supplies, please notify our parent coordinator, Ms. Lilly Chu at lchu@schools.nyc.gov.

- A backpack and lunchbox
- Face mask (extra face mask in backpack if at all possible)
- One box of # 2 pencils, sharpened and pencil case
- Two glue sticks
- One child-size scissors
- Three composition notebooks (gr. 1-5)
- One pencil sharpener with cover
- One pack of 24 crayons
- One pack of colored pencils
- One pack of washable markers
- Plastic pocket folder
- One headphone set (grades 3-5)
- Personal tissues (small pocket size)
- Dry erase markers
- Dry eraser (or sock)
- Water bottle (with child's name)
- One extra set of clothes in a plastic sealed/Ziploc® bag (pre-k & kindergarten, only)
- Tape
- Ruler
- Eraser

Once school has begun, classroom teachers may require additional supplies.

Any supplies left behind in March will be returned to students once we're back at school.
