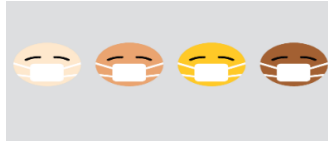

Dear PS 205 Families,

Student report cards will be available in New York City Schools Account (NYCSA) tomorrow Thursday April 15th. Please reach out to your child's teacher if you have any questions.

As you know there will not be any failing grades assigned to students this school year. As a reminder the grades assigned to students will be: 4 (exceeding standards), 3 (meeting standards), N (not meeting standards), NL (not enough student data). Science, Computer and Physical Education will also use MT (met standards).

I want to take this opportunity to thank all the families in grade 3 – 5 for responding to the New York State Exam Opt-In/Opt-Out survey. The ELA exam will be administered next week. A testing letter explaining what day and time the test will take place will be sent out to parents within the next two days. As of now each grade will be assigned to take the exam on a separate day. If your child is in the remote only cohort they will be able to be picked up after they finish their test. More details to follow so you can plan accordingly.

Lastly, we are happy to welcome back our opt-in students on Monday April 26th! All parents should have received their child's class and arrival/dismissal procedures from Ms. Chu. If you did not (or misplaced it in your inbox) don't worry, please reach out to Ms. Chu or call the school and we will give you the information. Please make sure that your child wears a mask to school and you complete the health survey before arriving to school each day. We are so happy to have the children back!
