- **Covid19 Guidance for Thanksgiving Recess**

- **Data Chats in the classroom** will continue to provide opportunities for students to take ownership of their learning by understanding their data and participating in goal setting and action planning.
- **Parent access to i-Ready Student Progress** is available. Login to your child's i-Ready account. Choose a subject (reading or math). At the bottom of the screen select "My Progress" – here you can see **Lesson Stats** and view **Completed Work**.
Please note that there are additional i-Ready resources for you to explore by clicking on the **Family Center** link in the upper right hand corner. There are videos, a family guide, and even *Fridge Tips for i-Ready Lessons at Home* that we have included with this email. - **Project Soapbox UPDATE**
Students in grades 3-5 will, again, be participating in this year's Project Soapbox, Mikva Challenge. Through this program, youth find their voice on the issues that matter most to them and are given a platform for sharing their ideas and actions. Here's how it works: students connect with issues they care about and develop their case for making a change. They'll create a powerful, researched, call-to-action speech about their selected issue. Select students will move on to the school-wide Soapbox event that will take place on **Wednesday December 7th**. Here they'll have the opportunity to share their speeches with their peers. One student will advance to the NYC Project Soapbox Challenge which will take place at the NY Historical Society on January 10th. Students in grade K-2 will be participating at the school level Soapbox event in the springtime. More information to follow.
Families of students who advance to the 205 Soapbox school event will be invited to attend. Please be advised that we still have to follow the NYC DOE visitor policy that requires all visitors to show proof of vaccination. Thank you for your understanding.
