# • Eureka Math

Eureka math is our school's math curriculum. We've been using this program for a few years now. The NY State Education Department launched this program in support of the NYS Math Standards and due to its nature in developing student's conceptual understanding in mathematics, we bought into the program. The Eureka Math curriculum is available online. In the past few years we have been able to purchase the Student Success-Homework book. Unfortunately this year we are unable to purchase it for two reasons: 1. Due to budget cuts we do not have funds to purchase the homework book and 2. We can no longer purchase the Student Success-Homework book because it's no longer available to purchase within the NYC DOE purchasing platforms (Shop DOE). Our first year using this program we made copies of the online homework for students. This year we are doing the same. To help families support their children with their math homework we have posted the Eureka Math Homework Helper pages for grades 1-5 on our website. Next year we will be part of a new math curriculum phase in with a program called Illustrative Math. More information about Illustrative Math will be shared
